

Music Classroom

Class Rules:

1. Listen and follow directions
2. Respect all materials
3. Raise your hand
4. Be nice

Whole Class:

The class could receive up to 4 points each class period:

- 1 point for entering class quietly
- 1 point for listening attentively
- 1 point for good effort
- 1 point for lining up to leave quietly

The class who is the first to accumulate 30 points will be recognized in a special showcase area of the cafeteria. Once a new class is recognized, a new round will begin and all classes will start again at zero points.

Individual:

Each student receives 5 participation points during each class period. Students begin each quarter with all points. Students maintain all points when all classroom rules are followed.

Consequences for choosing not to follow a music classroom rule:

1st offense - A verbal warning

2nd offense - "Under a Rest." The student will spend time away from the class, still in view and full participation of the activity. The student will be invited back when his/her behavior shows that the student wants to return.

(-2 daily participation points)

3rd offense - The student will fill out a behavior contract to be signed by the parent and returned at the next music class.

(-4 daily participation points)

Serious offenses, including threatening behavior and fighting, will result in a meeting with the principal.

A note about Renweb grades in Music Class:

After a 2nd offense, a student will receive 3 out of 5 participation points for the day. Renweb will recognize this as a "red" grade and send an e-mail notification to the parent. Please know that this score is not a representation of your student's overall grade. Please check the student's total points on Renweb. In most cases, the small number of points lost for the day will not severely impact the student's grade. The grade will also have a note to tell which rule was broken for all offenses.
